



The Dramatic Dash

James Bond Style

I can use dashes to show parenthesis.



Look at the sentences below. Either add a pair of dashes into the sentence (like in example 1) or a dash at the end to add some dramatic information (like in example 2).

Remember when the parenthesis is completely removed, the sentence still needs to be grammatically correct.

Example 1: James Bond – though I can't quite believe how - jumped straight over the car, rolled and ran off into the woods.

Example 2: It was a long wait – perhaps the longest of his life.

1. His Aston Martin pulled into the car park.

2. James Bond scanned the room.

3. The room was quiet other than a few people chatting in the corner.

4. Miss Moneypenny smiled across the room.

5. He looked at his watch.
