Task	Description
1	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>On your computer, open your internet browser (that's the one you use to search for things on the internet – maybe internet explorer, or google chrome).</li><li>Type this address into the browser bar at the top <a href="https://gms.j2webby.com/?cat=4">https://gms.j2webby.com/?cat=4</a></li></ul> <p>or click on the blue link, which should take you straight to the page in j2webby.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Click on the relevant section for you – if you are in year 5, click on the year 5 tab, year 6 on the year 6 tab etc. In here you can read my blog post – I've called it Mrs Parkin's lockdown lowdown. It tells you some of the things I've been doing while school has been closed.</li><li>At the end of the message, there is a link that says "leave a comment". Write me a reply, to say what you have been doing during the lockdown. Maybe you could tell me about the tasks you have completed for school, the books you have been reading and how the lockdown is making you feel.</li></ul> <p>Be careful to be kind though – choose your words carefully and don't be mean about anyone. Also, be careful with your spelling and punctuation, because lots of other people will be able to read it. Before you post your reply, maybe you could let your parents check it through – it's always good to let someone else check, as they can sometimes see mistakes that you have missed.</p>
