

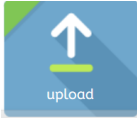
Year 8 Computing: Home Learning Week 6

Task	Description
1	<ul style="list-style-type: none">On your computer, open your internet browser (that's the one you use to search for things on the internet – maybe internet explorer, or google chrome). use this link to get Scratch and download it to your computer. Ask your parents' permission first! <p>rpf.io/scratchoff.</p> <p>If they don't want you to put Scratch on your computer, you can do it online here</p> <p>rpf.io/scratch-new</p>
2	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Follow the instructions in this link <p>https://projects.raspberrypi.org/en/projects/rock-band/1</p>
3	<ul style="list-style-type: none">When you have finished the project, save your work to your file on the computer. Do this in the same way that you would in school. Save into the place you are saving all your home learning – save it as “scratch musical instruments” and add your initials.
4	<ul style="list-style-type: none">When you have saved it, try uploading it to school 360, so that I can see it.To do this, first sign into school360 – there's an instruction sheet on the home learning page if you don't know how to do thisNow click on resources. This is on the main school360 screen.Then click on J2E  <ul style="list-style-type: none">Now click on upload – it looks like this

Then I should be able to have a look at your work. • If you can’t upload it to school360, <u>please don’t worry!</u> The main thing is, have a go at the task in Scratch!
