Some stickers have the letter H on them. What is the area of the letter H?

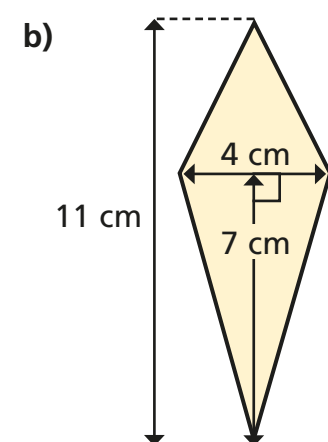

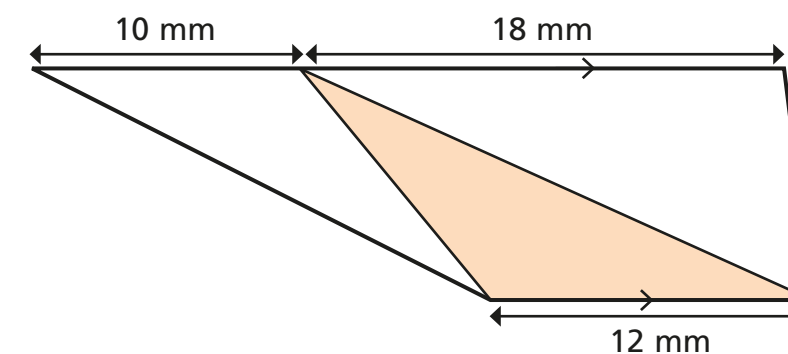
6 Dani makes a picture of a tree.
