PUPIL PREMIUM IN 2015-2016:

Glendale Community Middle School gains:

Free School Meals / Ever 6 pupils / Looked After Children = £41,921.65

Year 7 Catch Up pupils, Service Children = £2800

We have provided support for these pupils in a number of ways:

- Extra teacher hours to allow for splitting classes into ability sets.
- Differentiated activities for individual pupils in class.
- In class support with a teaching assistant.
- Small group withdrawal sessions with a teacher.
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- Lunchtime library and ELSA opportunities.
- Homework club four days a week with a teaching assistant.
- Supplying personal resources e.g. dictionaries.
- Continuing professional development to ensure the teaching in the classroom is the best that it can be.
- Contribute to the hardship fund so that FSM children are not excluded from activities, trips or access to uniform.
- Financial support to provide individual music tuition in school.
