

## Odd and Even Numbers

1. 18, 20, 24, 46
2. False; 32 should be in the even circle.
3. Odd – 25, 31, 39; Even – 28, 42, 44
4. Even (12 dots on the dice)
5. Any combinations totalling 5, 7 or 9, for example:  $1 + 4 = 5$ ,  $2 + 3 = 5$ ,  $1 + 6 = 7$ .
6.  $9 + 21 = 14 + 16$  OR  $21 + 9 = 16 + 14$
7. Kamron is correct. 45 is an odd number because it cannot be divided equally by 2.
