




Titanic: A Timeline of Major Events



	The plan to build the Titanic was approved.	The hull of the Titanic was finished and launched into sea for completion.	Sixteen lifeboats were placed on the decks of the Titanic.	The construction of the Titanic was completed.	The first sea trials for the Titanic were conducted. They last 12 hours.

	The Titanic was navigated to Southampton to prepare for launch.	Passengers board the Titanic and set sail toward France.	The Titanic picks up passengers in Ireland and travels in calm seas. 	Titanic receives several warnings from other ships about ice in the area.	Second Officer Lightoller warns the lookout to look "keenly" for ice.	Captain Smith goes to bed for the night. First Officer Murdoch is on duty on the bridge.	A nearby ship, the Californian, reports that they have stopped for the night because they are surrounded by fields of ice. The wireless operator tells him to "Shut Up. Shut Up!" and the message is never delivered.	From the crow's nest, the lookouts report "Ice Berg Right Ahead" to the bridge. Officer Murdoch reverses the engines and turns the ship.

	The Titanic strikes the iceberg and begins flooding. The watertight doors are closed.	Officer Murdoch inspects the ship and finds that the first six watertight compartments had already been breached.	The first lifeboat is launched at the same time that the first distress rocket is launched.	The last lifeboat is launched.	After breaking into two pieces, the Titanic sinks to the bottom of the Atlantic.
