These fruit are particularly interesting to draw when cut in half:

- Tomato
- Pepper
- Orange
- Kiwi
- Lemon
- Strawberry
- Grapefruit
- Watermelon
- Pomegranate

Next, use paint, coloured pencil or water colour pencil to complete colour studies of the same cross-sections. Sketch them again, this time without shading and then complete the colour study.
