| Task | Description   |
|------|---|
| 1    | <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>On your computer, open your internet browser (that's the one you use to search for things on the internet – maybe internet explorer, or google chrome).</li><li>Login to school 360. There are instructions on how to do this if you need them. They are on the home learning page of the school website.</li></ul> <p>Your login name is the same as your school login<br/>Your password should be the same as the school password, except with a capital letter.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Click on the resources link. Under the resources heading, find a blue button entitled “new” and click on that.</li></ul> |
| 2    | <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Click on the link to the Design Competition Intro Video – watch the video to see the details of the school 360 design competition.</li></ul>  |
| 3    | <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Now, on a new piece of paper, create a design of a new school360 pupil page layout.</li><li>Have a look at the template below. It contains all of the items that need to be on the design of your new school 360 layout.</li><li>You can draw this by hand, or do it on a computer program like paint – whichever is easiest for you.</li><li>The theme for the design is “Around the World”, so your drawing should relate to a country or place of your choice. It doesn't have to be in the same picture design as your student page is now – the design is up to you.</li></ul>   |
| 4    | <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>When you have finished your design, take a photo of it.
